

The bar loading magazines are a perfect match for single-spindle turning on INDEX and TRAUB CNC lathes. They feature short setup times and fast bar changes. Lowvibration bar guidance ensures optimal surface quality and dimensional accuracy.

Our MBL bar loading magazines are perfectly tailored to our multi-spindle automatic lathes. Fast and low vibration for optimal manufacturing results.

Basic configuration & guiding principle

- I The channels are adapted to the bar diameter with plastic reducers (bearing half shells)
- I Simple clip fasteners facilitate the setup of the bearing half
- I Optimized guidance of the bar stock
- I Fast bar change through intelligent process flow and fast axis
- I Precise alignment of the bar stock to the spindle center
- I Automated measurement of bar length
- I The guiding principle is also suitable for polygon bars


Bundle loader



Our machines offer different methods for integrated workpiece removal, as well as for the insertion of chuck and forged parts-quick, safe, and gentle.

- Discharging or flushing through counter spindle or turret
- I Gantry system for discharging workpieces onto a belt
- I Flexible feed and discharge with single or double gripperI Expandable with conveyor systems, robot, pallet station

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
Gantry-type removal unit and conveyor belt

- I Gantry-type removal unit (in Z axis direction) with NC drive
- I Automatic removal of machined workpiece from the main or counter spindle and subsequent placement on a conveyor belt or into a container
- I Removal of the remnant from the main spindle and separate placement into a remnant container

Workpiece handling unit WHU / WH1 / WH2

- I Integrated handling using one or two workpiece grippers
- I Feeding of blanks by means of conveyor belt or pallet
- I Removal of the machined workpiece from the counter spindle
- Integrated space-saving solution
- I For shaft or flange parts weighing up to 25 kg with a diameter up
- I Allows for flexible expansion, e.g. with circulating pallet conveyors





Workpiece feeding and removal by a 6-axis robot via a swivel disk to the external handling system

The workpiece handling system for chuck parts and bar segments can be used for multi-spindle machining with or without synchronized spindle, as well as for double 3 or 4-spindle machining.

Stationary workpiece removal via internal chute and conveyor belt

Workpieces removal through a chute onto the internal conveyor belt.

Position-aligned workpiece removal with intermediate gripper and linear shuttle

Rapid, damage-free, position-oriented removal by a linear and rotary motion. Workpieces are first transferred from the synchronous spindle to the intermediate gripper. The linear shuttle then transfers the workpieces to the external handling system during non-productive times.

Position-aligned workpiece removal with integrated parts conveyor

Workpieces are removed from the synchronous spindle and are aligned in position to the internal conveyor belt (for parts that may not be ejected).



Quality under control

With the iXcenter robot cell, blanks and finished parts can be fed and discharged quickly, safely, and flexibly. Depending on the type and size of machine, the robot cell is ergonomically integrated and allows for flexible modular expansion based on your requirements.



The overall sequence between the machine and the robot cell is created using predefined macros in the NC program. The robot accesses the machine's work area through the automatic work area door.


